

Preface to the Special Issue on The World Congress on Engineering 2007

The World Congress on Engineering has been organized by the International Association of Engineers (IAENG), a non-profit international association for the engineers and the computer scientists. The WCE 2007 took place in Imperial College London, London, United Kingdom, 2-4 July, 2007.

The focus of our congress is on the frontier topics in the theoretical and applied engineering and computer science subjects. The WCE conferences have been serving as good platforms for our members and the entire engineering community to meet with each other and to exchange ideas. The conferences have also stroke a balance between theoretical and application development.

Our WCE 2007 has been organized with congress committees that have been formed with over two hundred and eighty committee members who are mainly research center heads, faculty deans, department heads, professors, and research scientists from over 20 countries. The conferences are truly international meetings with a high level of participation from many countries.

The response that we have received for the congress is excellent. The WCE 2007 has attracted more than five hundred participants from over 20 countries. All submitted papers have gone through the peer review process. The summary of submissions and accepted papers in WCE 2007 is as followed: total number of submissions reviewed: 756; total number of accepted papers: 431. And the overall acceptance rate in our congress is 57.01%. Manuscripts have been selected for the special issues of the IAENG journals, based on the review scores and the evaluation comments by the conference session chairs.
